

North Carolina Plant Food Industry Hall of Fame

Nomination Form

Organizations or individuals may submit nominations to the North Carolina Plant Food Industry Hall of Fame.

The information provided with this nomination form should contain as much background and as many details as possible. Completed packets should reflect the nominee's contributions to the plant food industry. Please do not exceed three (3) typed pages, excluding this form.

Selection Criteria

Induction into the North Carolina Plant Food Industry Hall of Fame is the highest honor bestowed by the industry. The North Carolina Plant Food Industry Hall of Fame provides recognition for individuals contributing in especially significant ways to the fertilizer industry.

In making its decision, the Plant Food Association of NC (PFANC) Board of Directors considers the criteria listed below. In order to help the Board make its selection, please provide detailed information on the major contributions and activities of the nominee relating to these criteria as well as the individual's commitment and contributions to their community. Application should not exceed three (3) pages.

- Demonstrated innovation, personal commitment, leadership and vision beyond the professional requirements of the position in the plant food industry they were engaged or employed. If nominee was not employed by the industry, please indicate how he/she demonstrated the same qualities to advance the plant food industry.
- 2. Achieved identifiable and lasting changes to improve and/or promote the plant food industry.
- 3. Commitment to serve the plant food industry through years of service, membership, leadership, etc. Recognized for work in or relating to the plant food industry.
- 4. Individual commitment and contributions to their community.

Deadline for Nominations

Nomination must be received by the Plant Food Association of North Carolina **no later than May 1.** Nominations and letters received after this date will be considered for the following year.

All nominations and supporting materials may be utilized in newsletters, press releases or other communications to recognize the nominee or promote the Hall of Fame.

Selection Pool

Nominations are held in the selection pool for three (3) consecutive years.

Selection Approval Process

The elected board of directors of the Plant Food Association of NC, Inc. shall serve as the governing body for the process of review and ranking nominees for recognition.

Recognition

Inductees selected for inclusion in the North Carolina Plant Food Industry Hall of Fame will be recognized during the banquet at the Summer Meeting of the Plant Food Association of North Carolina.
